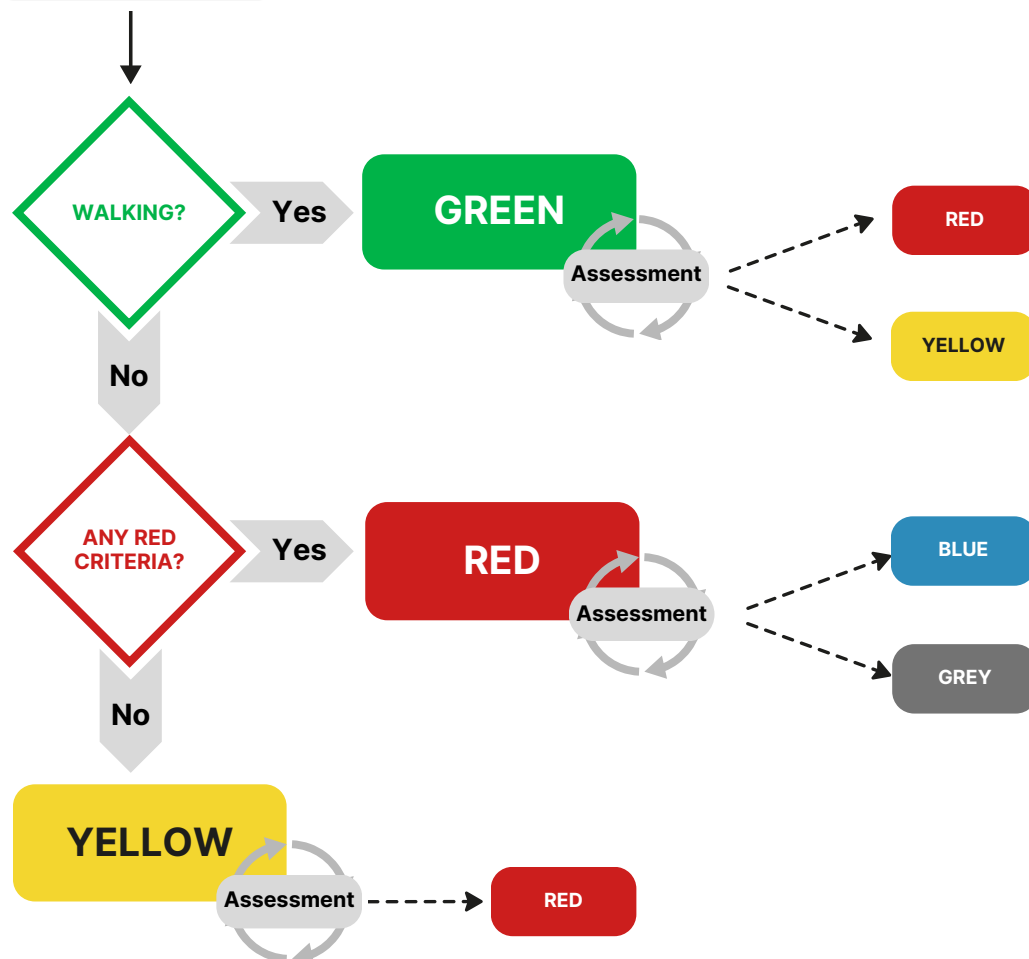


# MASS CASUALTY- INTERAGENCY INTEGRATED TRIAGE TOOL

## TRIAGE CATEGORIES

INITIAL TRIAGE POINT



### RED CRITERIA

- A - Airway compromise
- B - Respiratory distress
- C - Major haemorrhage\* OR no radial pulse  
OR capillary refill > 3 sec
- D - Altered mental status or unresponsive
- Massive burn (>40% BSA)
- Clinician concern

\*massive or catastrophic

### BLUE CRITERIA

- Meets criteria for medical futility OR
- Requires palliative services OR
- Requires curative treatment beyond current capacity

### GREY CRITERIA

- Not breathing after airway manoeuvres AND
- No pulse

### Assessment

When detailed assessment is delayed, repeat triage with Mass Casualty - IITT.

Assessment includes evaluation of ABCDE conditions and high risk vital signs.

Conduct further triage as needed based on patient assessment or clinical concern.

### High Risk Vital Signs
